ACHIEVEMENT OF THE INSTITUTE (2021-22)

- ❖ Capacity building and training programmes: A total of 501 farmers and officials have been provided training through online on various aspects of horticulture by the Institute such as Cultivation of exotic vegetables, Production technology & post harvest management and nursery management & accreditation.
- ❖ Production of quality planting material: The Institute produces a variety of plants in its nursery units with the objective to provide disease free quality planting material. A total of 34,590 nos. of rootstocks of Citrus, mango, Cashew nut and guava have been raised and 46,580 Quality Planting materials have been propagated & produced for Citrus, Dragonfruit, Avocado, litchi, Cashewnut, Mango and Guava
- ❖ Demonstration of improved production technologies: The Institute has established demonstration plots of fruit crops (Khasi Mandarin, Acid Lime, Pear, Plum, Jamun, Guava, Avocado, Kiwi & Dragon fruit), vegetables (Okra, French bean, chilli, Indian bean, cowpea, bottlegourd), seasonal flowers, Cultivation of capsicum, tomato and cucumber under protected structures, oyster mushroom production.

The Institute has also distributed planting materials of Guava, Acid lime, bottle gourd and Drumstick to the farmers under Peren District, Nagaland. Peach, Plum and Pear were also distributed for demonstration at Integrated Horticulture Model in Punglwa B village, Peren District of Nagaland.

- ❖ Post harvest management Under post harvest management, the Institute has prepared oil less pickle, ginger candy, strawberry jam, Peach RTS, raw mango chutney, mango squash, pineapple squashes, carombola candy etc. Online review meeting with the certificate course trainees on post harvest management and online training on Post harvest management &value addition were also conducted.
- ❖ Marketing and agri-business promotion: Under Agri business promotion, the Institute has organized Training on Basics of DPR preparation and Entrepreneurship Development Ex-trainees and FPC members; Market promotion programme for organic pineapples from Nagaland with Molsang FPC at Bungsang village, Dimapur, Nagaland and Coordinated Market linkage of organic pineapples of Nagaland to New Delhi
- ❖ Workshops: Organized Sensitization workshop on Opportunities for Agri Startups and Entrepreneurs in North East Region on 11th August 2021 in collaboration with NEATEHUB, AAU, Jorhat.
- Bharat ka Amrut Mahotsav: Organized field day on vegetable at Ngwalaw village, Peren district; Field Day on harvesting of onion was conducted at Punglwa B' village under Peren district of Nagaland; Organised Pineapple festival at Medziphema village.
